Dear Miss Zingg:

Another year has rolled around since we exchanged correspondence about reports on the Foundation's grant of \$50,000. You will recall sending the excellent "financial" report in August, 1968 and interceding with Mr. Rieben to send us a "narrative" detailing progress over the past year.

Would it be possible to send us a financial for 1968 and 1969? And to receive Mr. Rieben's updated comments of what has transpired since his last report?

Also, would you be able to let me know whether you and Mr. Rieben think the project will be completed by the end of December. As you will recall, our letter of September 3, 1968 extended the grant through December 31, 1969. If committed funds will not have been expended by that time so that a FINAL report could be sent to us, then it would be necessary for us to do another (third) extension of the grant period. On the other hand, if you think all will be finished by the end of the year, I would suggest you and Mr. Rieben wait until then to do the final report and not bother with an interim one. But it would be helpful to know if you plan to do this.

Dear Mr. Brueckner:

Enclosed for your information is a brief narrative statement and financial reports for the years 1967 and 1968 with respect to the Ford Foundation's grant of \$10,000 for research and preparation of original materials on the European integration movement, including special emphasis on work on Dr. Jean Monnet's personal efforts.

The current balance of funds is \$11,170.00. I would like to point out that this amount, although unspent, is restricted.

There has been very little activity during the past two years due to constant preoccupation with the work of the Heller Committee for the United States of Europe. It is anticipated, however, that work will resume in 1970 and will continue until the project for which the grant was made is completed. It is not possible to say exactly how long a time this will require but if it is possible for the Foundation to extend the grant for another two years, we would be extremely grateful.
